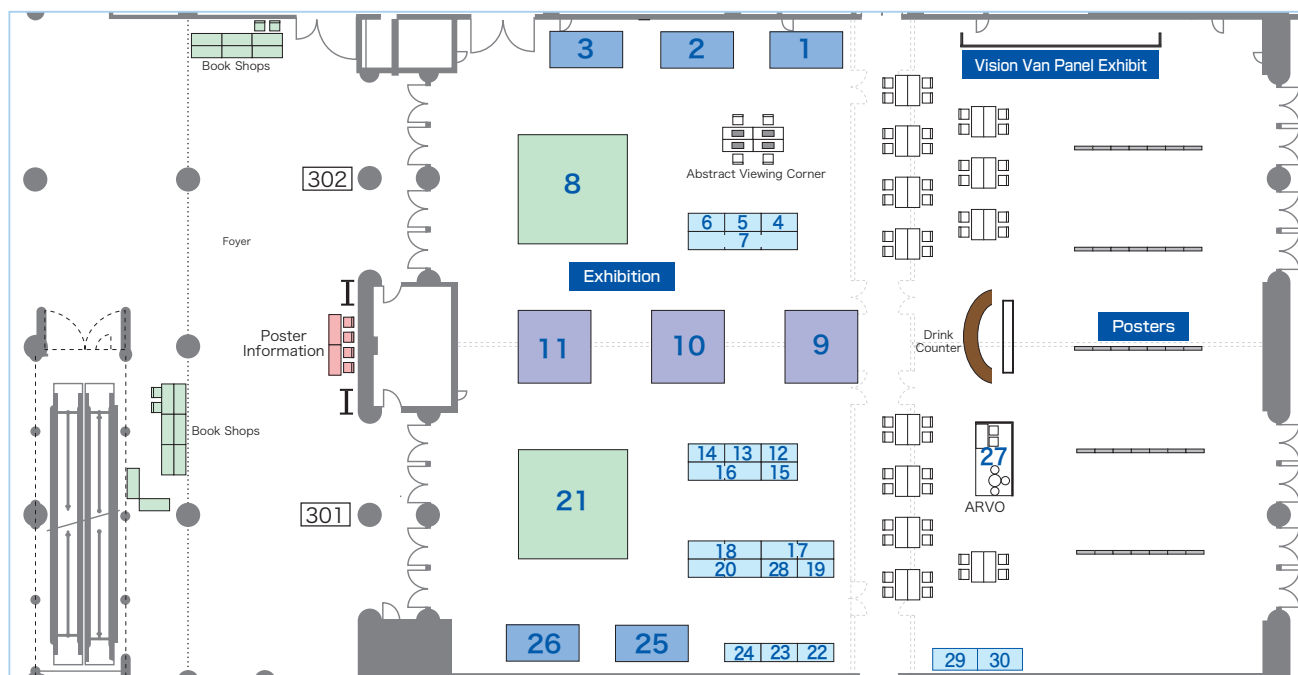

Vision Van

The need for an ophthalmological care support vehicle was realized during the Great East Japan Earthquake of March 2011. In order to dispense needed eye care, the Bascom Palmer Vision Van, a mobile eye care unit, was airlifted to Japan from the University of Miami in the U.S.

The Bascom Palmer Vision Van missions in the Tohoku region drew attention to emergency eye care readiness, prompting Japan to create its own version. Since its launch in 2013, the Japanese Vision Van has continued its rounds in the Tohoku disaster zone, standing ready for dispatch to domestic sites in times of crisis and to overseas disaster areas in relief operations. One such mission was its deployment to the Philippines after Super Typhoon Haiyan (Yolanda) ravaged the country in November 2013. From February 19-28, 2014, the Vision Van provided 1,922 disaster victims with much-needed eye care.
